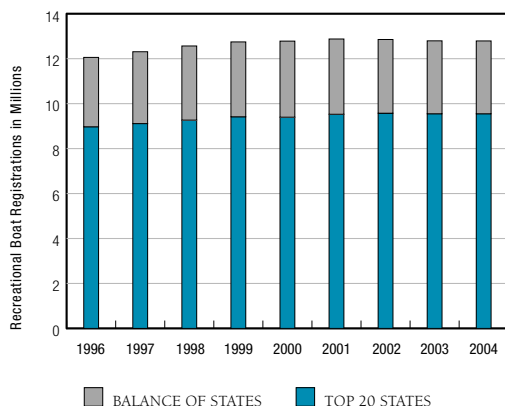
Top 20 States Recreational Boat Registrations for 2004

The top 20 states account for almost three out of every four boats registered in the U.S., a total of 9.5 million boats.

Although total U.S. boat registrations decreased slightly in 2004, registrations increased in ten of the top 20 states. Illinois and Iowa exhibited the largest gains, 9.3% and 8.2% respectively.
