Figure 1. Location of the Connecticut 1st Congressional District

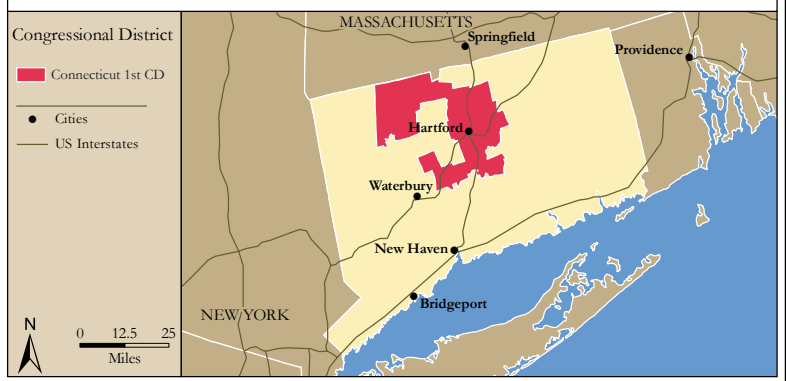


Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Connecticut 1st Congressional District

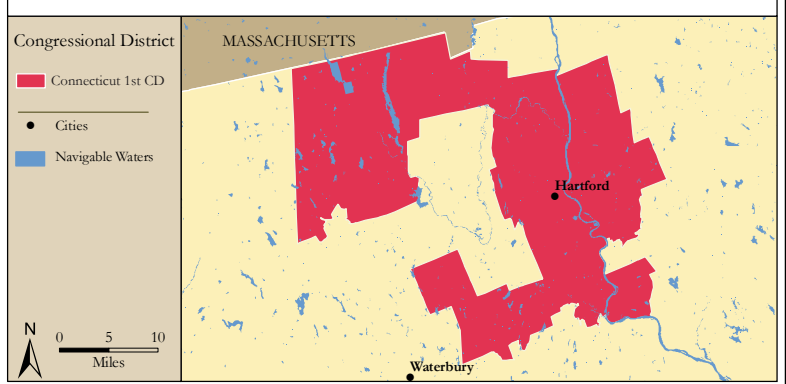


Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 1st Congressional District

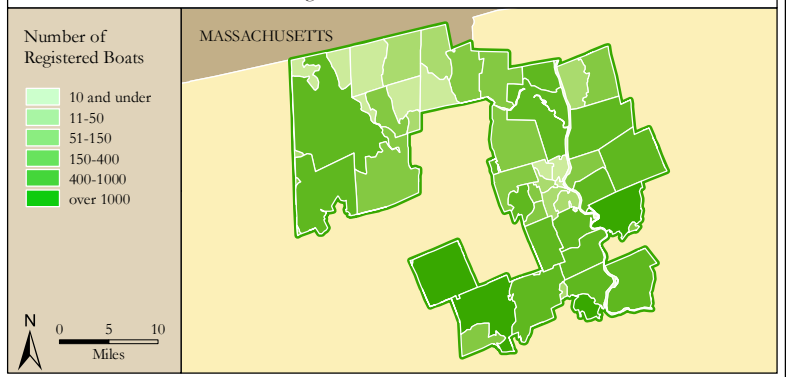
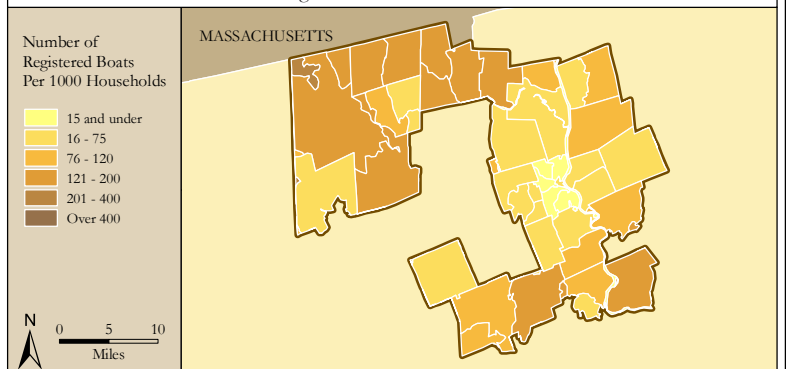


Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 1st Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Connecticut 2nd Congressional District

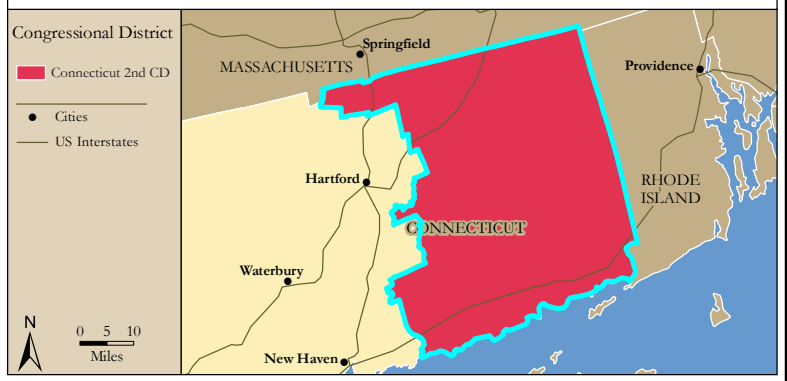


Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Connecticut 2nd Congressional District

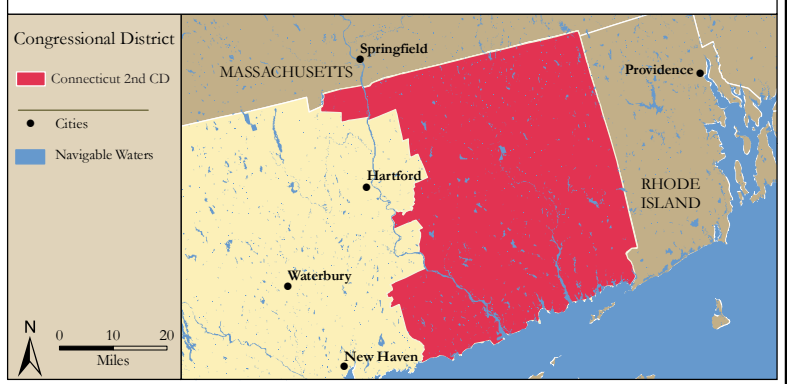


Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 2nd Congressional District

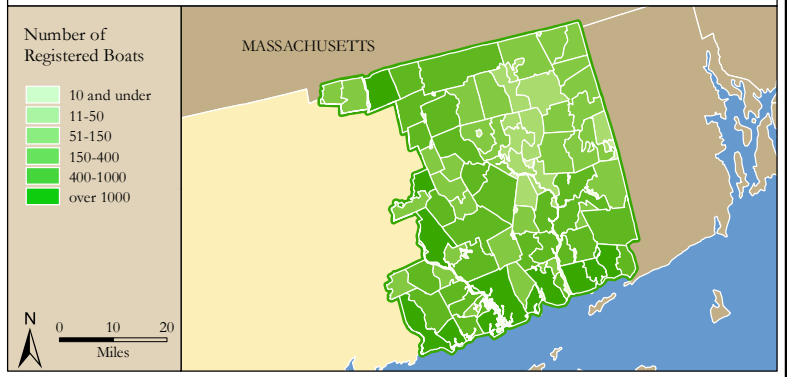
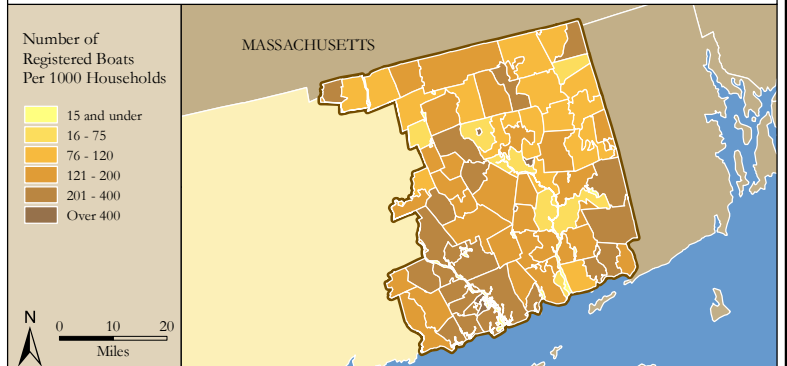


Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 2nd Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Connecticut 3rd Congressional District

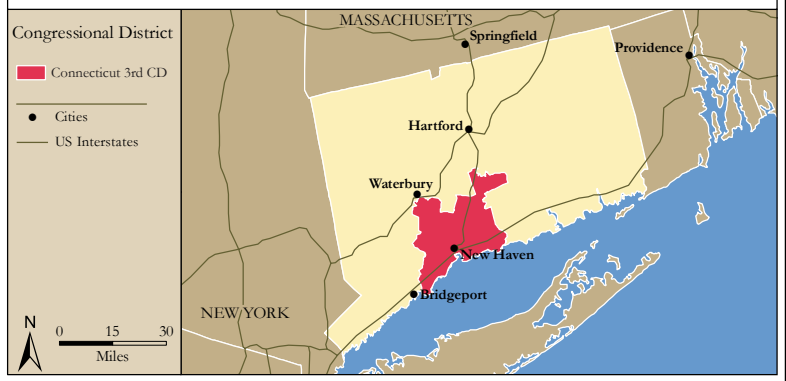


Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Connecticut 3rd Congressional District

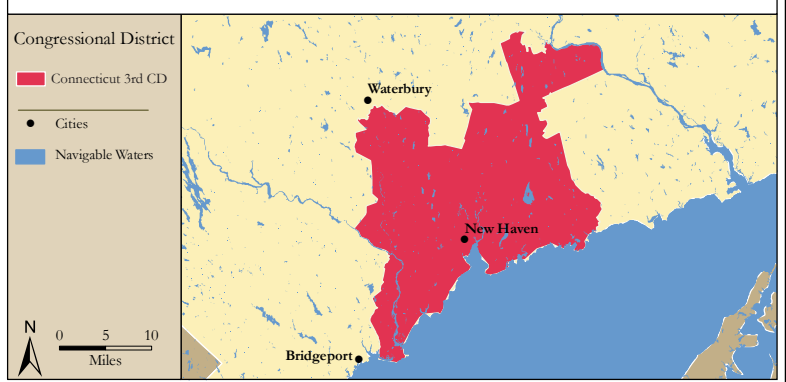


Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 3rd Congressional District

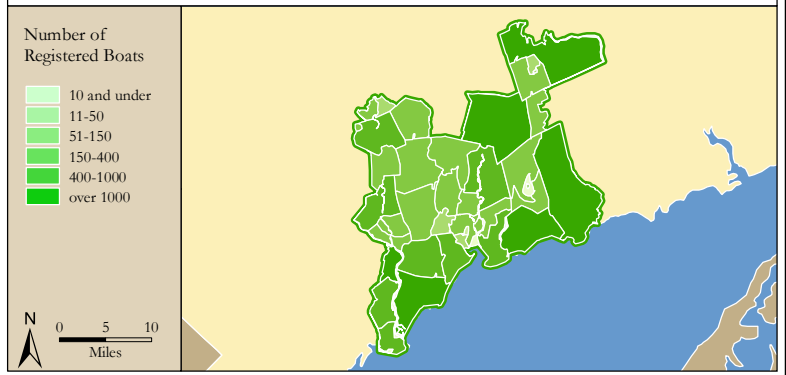
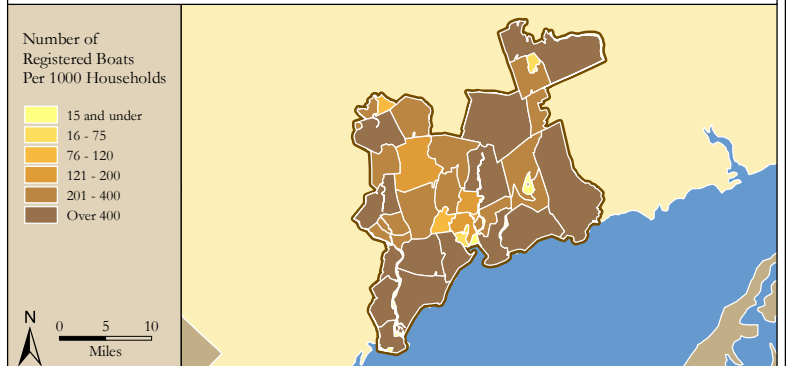


Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 3rd Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Connecticut 4th Congressional District

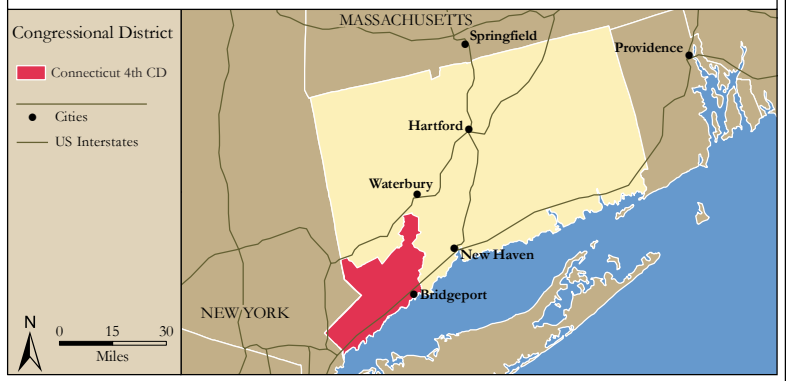


Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Connecticut 4th Congressional District

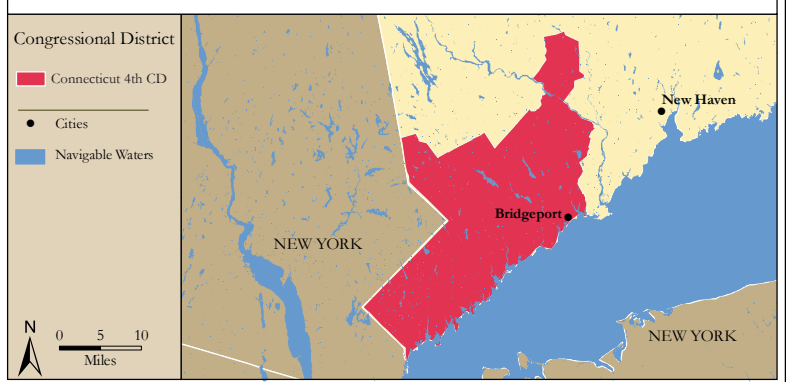


Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 4th Congressional District

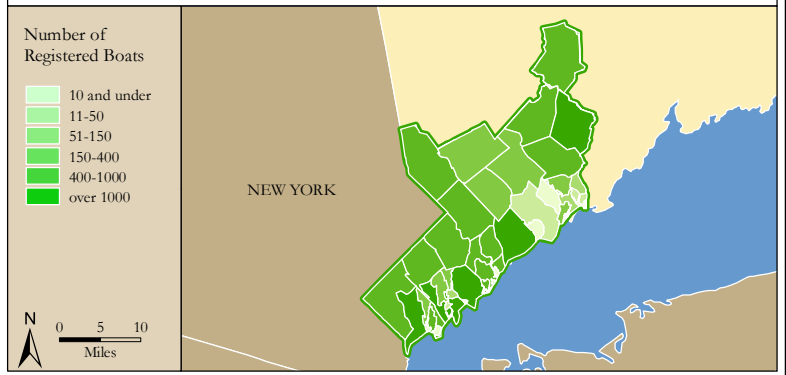
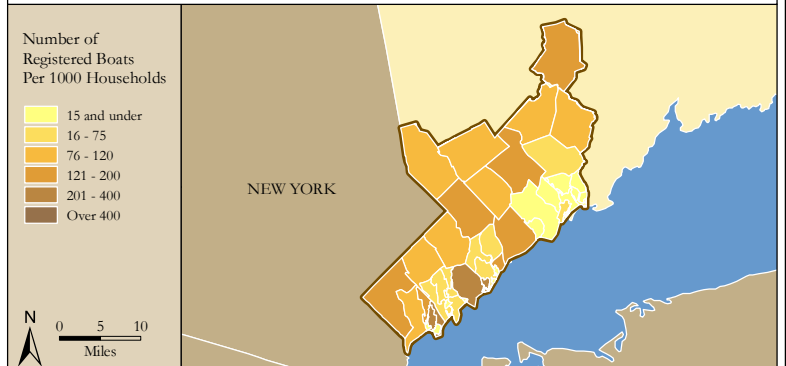


Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 4th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Connecticut 5th Congressional District

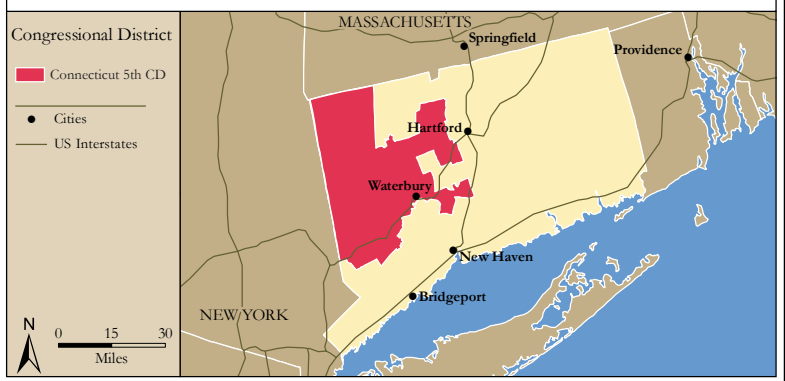


Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Connecticut 5th Congressional District

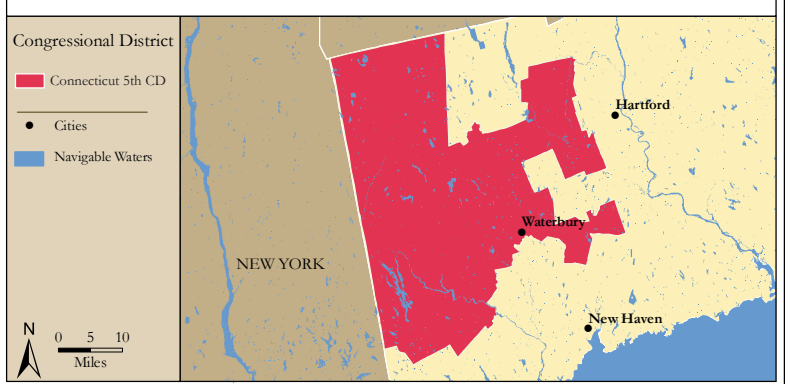


Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 5th Congressional District

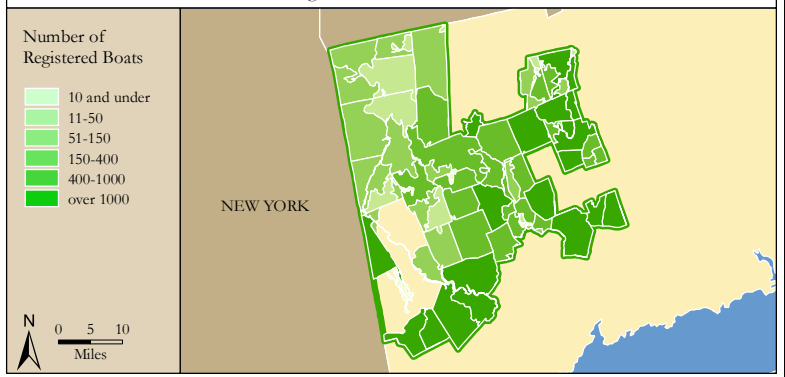
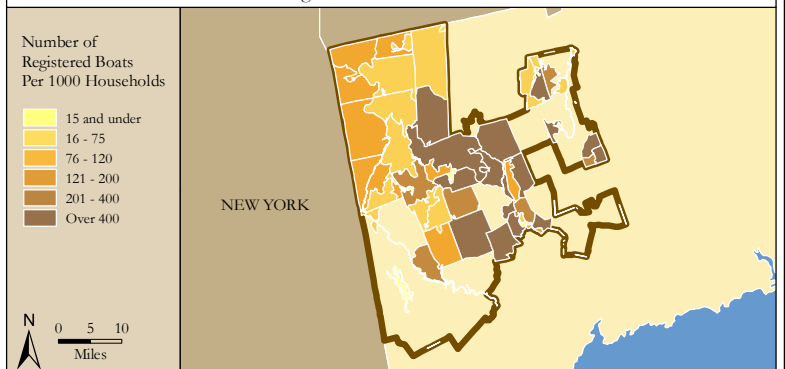


Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Connecticut 5th Congressional District
