Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 1st Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 1st Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 1st Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 1st Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 2nd Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 2nd Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 2nd Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 2nd Congressional District

Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 3rd Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 3rd Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 3rd Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 4th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 4th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 4th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 4th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 5th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 5th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 5th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 5th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 6th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 6th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 6th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 6th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 7th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 7th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 7th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 7th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 8th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 8th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 8th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 8th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 9th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 9th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 9th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 9th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 10th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 10th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 10th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 10th Congressional District

Figure 1. Location of the Virginia 11th Congressional District




Figure 2. Navigable Waters of the Virginia 11th Congressional District




Figure 3. Number of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 11th Congressional District





Figure 4. Per Capita (Household) Ownership of Registered Boats by Zipcode within the Virginia 11th Congressional District
